

# Skeleton Resolution - Political Committee - QMUN2 2021

## The Situation in Afghanistan: short-, medium- and long-term strategies

*Acknowledging* the past 20 years of NATO involvement in Afghanistan's socioeconomic reform,

*Noting* ISIS-K's presence and interests,

*Understanding* the importance of upholding traditional Islamist values to the people of Afghanistan,

*Fully aware* of the international crimes that the Taliban has committed,

*Mindful* of the Taliban's impact on views of Islam in the West,

*Conscious* of the current humanitarian crisis that the people of Afghanistan face,

*Recognising* the UN's previous efforts to determine an interior government,

*Affirming* the importance of the eventual independence of Afghanistan.

1. **Urges** the continuation of any and all efforts from the UN and its infinite resources to:
  - a) evacuate all remaining Afghan people from Afghanistan who want to leave the country,
  - b) supply schools in Afghanistan with books and resources to resume and continue education for children during and after conflicts,
  - c) provide aid to communities in Afghanistan in the form of food and clean water,
  - d) educate communities on how to survive during frequent food shortages and droughts, thus
2. **Recommends** the formation of a task force to enforce Clause 1,
3. **Encourages** the UN and its member states to hold meetings with representatives of the Taliban in order to negotiate the abolition of rules and laws that do not adhere to The Universal Declaration of Human Rights (1948),
4. **Requests** that no member state should under any circumstance engage in combat with the Taliban or ISIS-K in Afghanistan without discussion with the UN and its member states beforehand.
