The issue of ensuring responsible use of AI in public crisis information systems

Acknowledging that AI has the potential to significantly enhance the speed, accuracy, and reach of public crisis information systems to civilians during emergencies, thereby possibly saving lives and improving public safety

Understanding that the integration of AI technologies into crisis communication must be governed by ethical frameworks to ensure transparency, fairness, and accountability for all users

Recognising that crises such as natural disasters, pandemics, and political conflicts require timely and accurate delivery of information to prevent both panic and possible misinformation

Taking into consideration that biased or incomplete data used to train AI models can lead to unequal access to critical information towards marginalised or underrepresented communities

Bearing in mind that the misuse or manipulation of AI-driven communication systems by authoritarian regimes or malicious actors could erode public trust and endanger the lives of civilians
